Do you know the basic signs of a pet emergency?

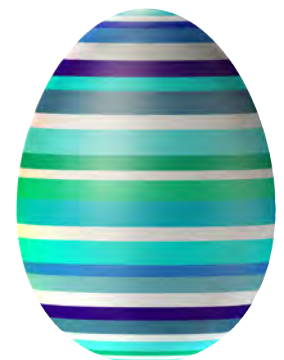
