When Mike first started the job, however, he wasn't sure it was for him. SEACON flaggers are responsible for keeping motorists, pedestrians, construction crews, and equipment operators safe while work is being performed. It requires constant attention, clear communication, quick decision-making, and a commitment to protecting everyone who travels through a work zone. Like many flaggers, Mike found himself on the receiving end of frustration from drivers unhappy about traffic delays. After about a month, he had decided to move on. Then something unexpected happened. Two tour operators from Alaska Hummer Adventures started waving back. That simple gesture sparked something in Mike. Drawing from his Southern upbringing, he decided that if people were frustrated, he would meet them with kindness. He started waving at as many passers-by as possible. Before long, more and more people waved back.

Today, "ZZ Stop" has become something of a local celebrity. Whether it's a wave, a smile, or simply a positive attitude, Mike has turned an ordinary workday into an opportunity to brighten someone else's. Many drivers now look forward to seeing him on their daily commute, knowing they'll be greeted with a smile and a wave.
